Rosanne Trapani, CSC/CI/CT, and Julie Balassa MA (Education of the Deaf), CI/CT, C-Print Captionist, are back and will conduct this follow-up workshop to enhance interpreter understanding of concepts and vocabulary in basic math and beginning algebra levels. Participants will further their understanding of the foreign language of mathematics, and review application of the Cummins Model in developing strategies and sign choices ranging from pure ASL to conceptually accurate English. This workshop will add to the interpreter’s vocabulary in academic mathematical settings and provide further understanding of the multiple meanings of mathematical terms.
